I am intrigued by the neuronal underpinnings of consciousness in the human brain. Therefore, my future research will focus on exploring the differences and similarities in the processing of consciously and unconsciously acquired information in the human brain, with the aim of contributing to our understanding of the phenomenon of consciousness. I am currently working on my master's thesis in the Cognitive Neuroscience of Memory and Consciousness lab at the University of Bern, where I am involved in the theoretical assessment of the differences and similarities between conscious and unconscious processing.
